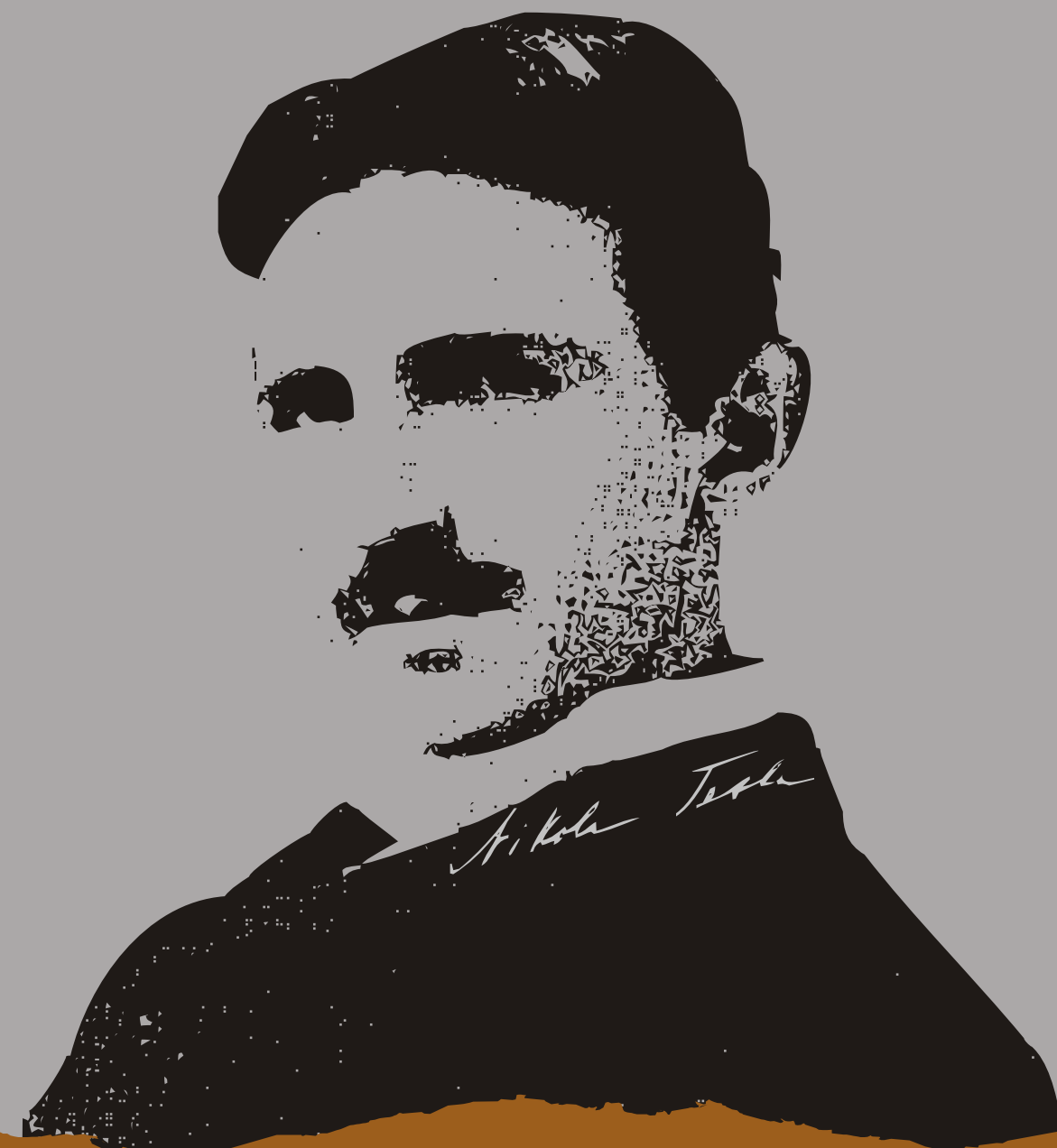

Nikola Tesla

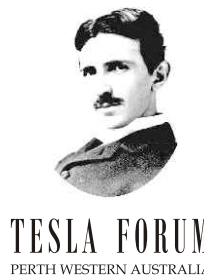
Nikola Tesla (1856-1943) was the genius who lit the world, whose discoveries in the field of polyphase alternating-current systems advanced the world into the modern industrial era.

Tesla had 700 patents in the USA and Europe and his discoveries also include the fluorescent light, wireless transmission of electrical energy, radio, remote control, Tesla Coil, terrestrial waves and the use of the ionosphere for scientific purposes.

Conference

The International Conference "Nikola Tesla The Man Who Lit the World" will take place on Friday 7 July 2006 at the Perth Convention Centre in Western Australia. Year 2006 is the 150th Anniversary of Nikola Tesla's birth and the Conference will be held as part of the wider 2006 Tesla Day Celebration.

The Celebration is organized by the Tesla Forum of Western Australia Inc. (Tesla Forum), a non-profit organization in association with the Scitech, Western Power, ABB, Engineers Australia and three leading universities: Curtin University of Technology, University of Western Australia and Murdoch University and other professional organizations and companies.



Scope of the Conference

The conference is focused on the legacy of Nikola Tesla and the importance of scientific work and education. It will serve as a good platform for the professional community, as well as the general public, to meet and exchange views and ideas on how to use Tesla's heritage to promote awareness about the importance of education and scientific work within the wider community and especially among youth.

Science today - some new achievements and new ideas will be highlighted.

The abstract should include: (1) Title of the paper; (2) Name, affiliation and e-mail address for each author; (3) A maximum of 5 keywords of the paper (4) short summary of paper. The conference session in which paper is going to be presented should be stated in the subject and the body of the email.

Reviewing process and the notification of acceptance will be completed by the 7 May 2006.
