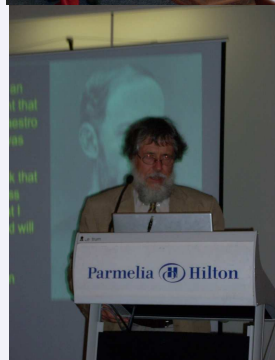
## Tesla Forum -
